project. A donation is requested of the MBTC to help fund project. Motion was  
made for \$1500 donation and seconded. Discussion followed of design ideas, etc.

Reports and Updates:

Ron Lacy (Mayors office) : discussed water rationing, budget gap, OVO; mayor  
needs to know where the 2mil is going to come from to fund program- need to  
address certain issues like truckers, etc. Council is dark in August.

Thyme Warner (Councilman's office); discussed OVO, 2mil is needed for city  
wide OVO. Faulconer wants his district to be a pilot for program, will cost \$70K.  
Says the rest of council won't approve the funding because it will trickle down to

their areas. Questions were asked why area in front of Bahia doesn't allow RV's due to Mission Bay park district.

Police Captain Zimmerman: Many big thanks for Public Safety Services 4<sup>th</sup> of July BBQ! Everyone really enjoyed the food and hospitality.

Stats-1.2 mil people went to beach, more folks than last year. More families, less problems. Violators stand out more. Irish vice council visited problem houses. "Open carry" guys were back. One fewer house parties than last year. Advocates calling early on problems. Decibel meters are in, training forthcoming. Will do some pro-active enforcement on RV's.

Shawn (Kehoe's office): Income down so state is hurting. Needs 2/3 majority for change. New tax rates in effect, as a result folks may want adjust withholding.

Neighborhood Watch:

Bill Bradshaw: Neighborhood Watch Meeting July 23<sup>rd</sup> 6-8 PM. Overall improvement in crime stats: significant drop violent crime. Auto burglaries up.
