President Mary Swenson called the meeting to order at 7 PM and led the Pledge of allegiance. Board members, guests and presenters were introduced.

Minutes: April 9 minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's Report: (Will Gardner): General Fund balance: \$8,022.93 and Utility Box Painting Fund balance: \$120.62. Approved as presented.

President's Report: Mary reported on the Mayoral Candidate Debate at La Jolla High on May 9 and the History presentations at the Woman's Club on April 9 and 16.
